

ROOTVILLE CEMETERY

ATHENS TOWNSHIP-CRAWFORD CO., PA.-CEM.NO.1

This cemetery is plainly visible a half mile below Rootville on the west side of Rt.20082 just above a church and on a hillside. It was first indexed by "R.C.T." and published in Erie, Pa. newspaper in the 1920's. Eugene F. Throop then indexed it in Sept.1968 and rechecked it Sept.1,1969. It has veterans graves and is well cared for. In 1969 I found four recent graves marked only by flowers and three funeral home markers which were completely illegible. I counted 263 marked graves ranging from 1855 to 1985 and I have added to the index data from obituaries in the Meadville, Pa. newspaper since 1973.
